



We will be discussing the book, Hello Beautiful by Ann Napolitano and January's book, And Then There Were None by Agatha Christie.

## Exercise classes offered at St. John's in Little Suamico

1 in 4 people over the age of 65 fall each year. A fall can cause injury that restricts activity and may hinder the return to prior level of activity. Staying in our own home is the priority as we enter advanced age. However, for this to happen we must be capable and able to accomplish a variety of daily tasks safely. This class will teach you how to stay strong and independent by performing simple balance and strengthening exercises. **The class requires a sign up of 4 people. There will be 10 sessions for a cost of \$25. The class will meet each Tuesday from 10:50 to 11:20 beginning February 4<sup>th</sup>.**

This exercise class is for those who find it difficult to fit exercise into their busy lifestyle. They may have found themselves steadily gaining weight, have lost strength and endurance and do not feel comfortable in a gym setting. Exercises will focus on improving strength, endurance, agility and balance. The class requires a sign up of 8 people. **There will be 10 sessions at a cost of \$25. The class will meet each Tuesday from 10:00 to 10:45 beginning February 4<sup>th</sup>.**

My name is Donna Zunker, and I will be the instructor for these classes. I am certified through the International Sports and Science Association as a Senior Exercise Specialist and am also certified in Corrective Exercise through ISSA. I am currently seeking certification in Training the Older Adult. As we age the aches and pains catch up with us and we find ourselves sitting more and generally becoming inactive. At 73 years old I found that is the worst thing to do. Our joints and bones require consistent movement and exercise. Join a class and learn simple ways to maintain your independence and feel better.



## Thank you!

As many of you know, I am on the Oconto Blue Devils Trap Team and have been for 2 years. I have placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in our conference in the female division for the past 2 years (or 4 seasons).

We have a fall and spring season. Our high school team has grown to over 20 youth this past season! Kids that are in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades that have an interest in trap shooting are encouraged to join the team to sharpen their skills before moving onto the high school team.

The Oconto Blue Devils Trap Team has had the opportunity to compete: in the spring at the Crivitz Invitational Trap Shoot, in the fall at the Blue Devil Invitational Trap Shoot, in June at the State Trap Shooting Tournament in Wisconsin Rapids and in July at the USA High School Clay Target League National Championship in Lansing, MI.

The Trap Team was looking for donations/sponsorships to help in purchasing a team canopy and an enclosed trailer used to move the needed equipment and supplies to the competitions listed above and many local events.

Thru the huge generosity of our friends and family at St. John's Church, the Brotherhood and WELCA have donated \$250 each!
